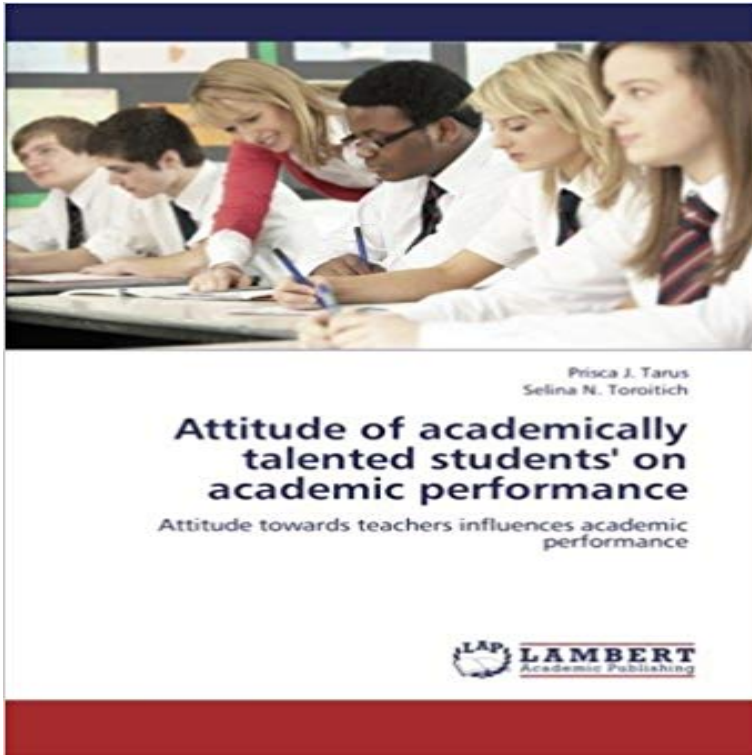


Attitude of academically talented students on academic performance: Attitude towards teachers influences academic performance
