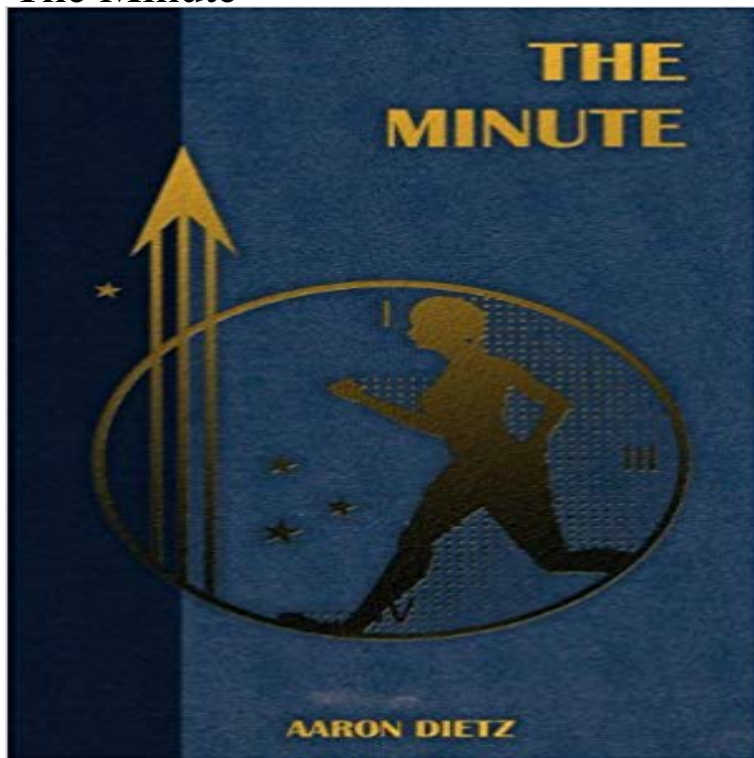


The Minute
