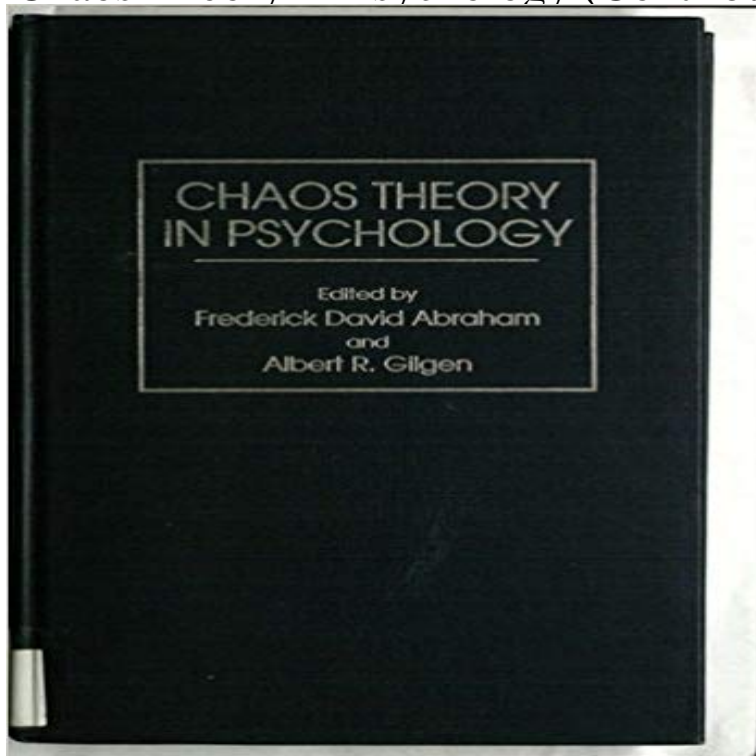


## Chaos Theory in Psychology (Contributions in Psychology)
