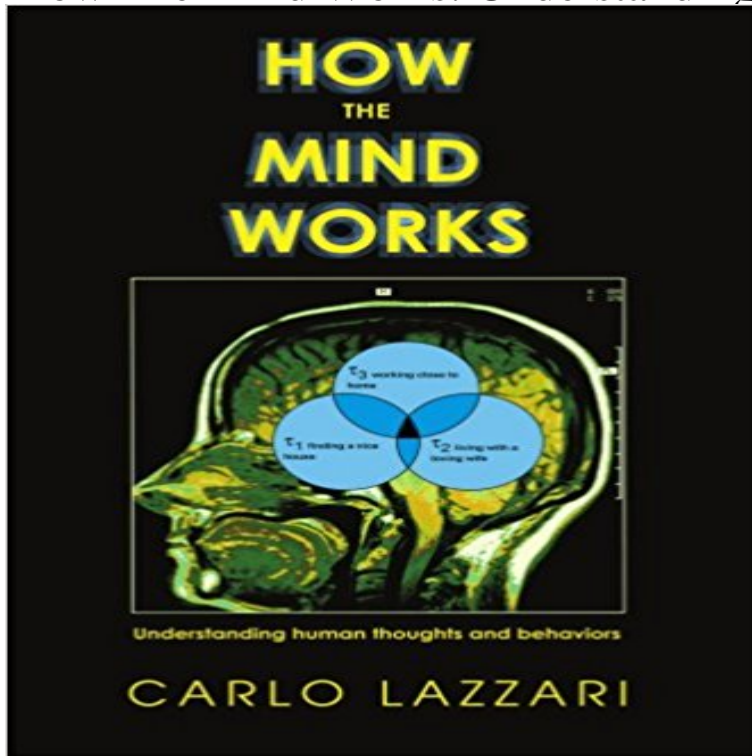


# How The Mind Works: Understanding human thoughts and behaviors
