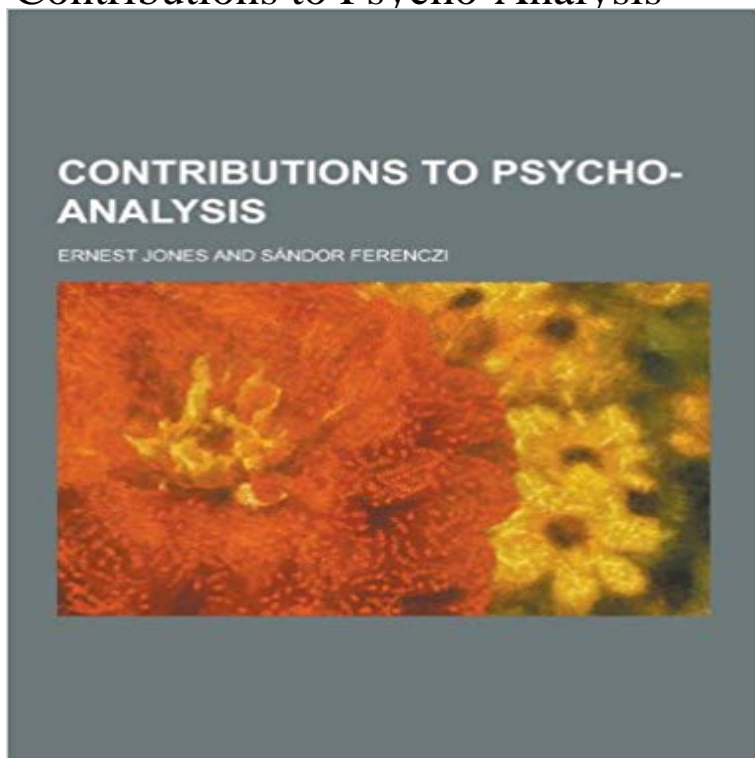

Introjection in the Neuroses THE productivity of the neurosis (during a course of psycho-analytic treatment) is far from being extinguished, but exercises itself in the creation of a peculiar sort of thoughtformation, mostly unconscious, to which the name transferences may be given. These transferences are re-impressions and reproductions of the emotions and phantasies that have to be awakened and brought into consciousness during the progress of the analysis, and are characterised by the replacement of a former person by the physician. In these sentences Freud announced, in the masterly description of a hysterical case,<sup>1</sup> one of his most significant discoveries. Whoever since then, following Freuds indications, has tried to investigate psycho-analytically the mental life of neurotics, must have become convinced of the truth of this observation.
