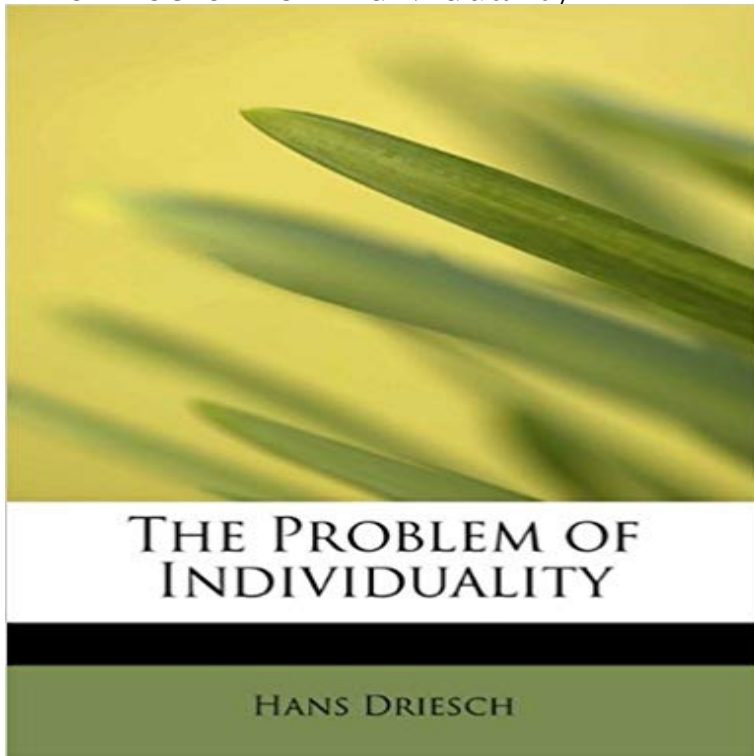


The Problem of Individuality
