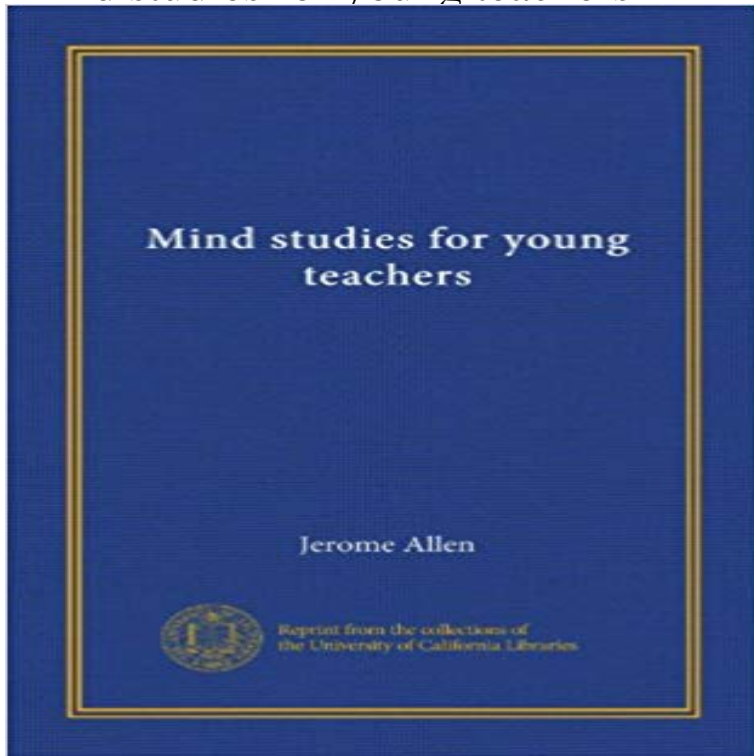


Mind studies for young teachers
