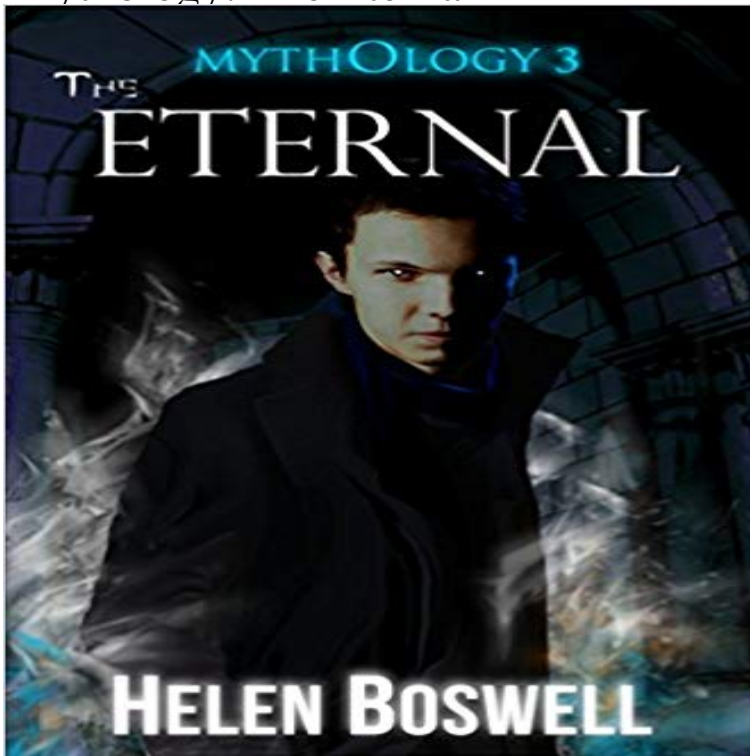


Mythology: The Eternal
