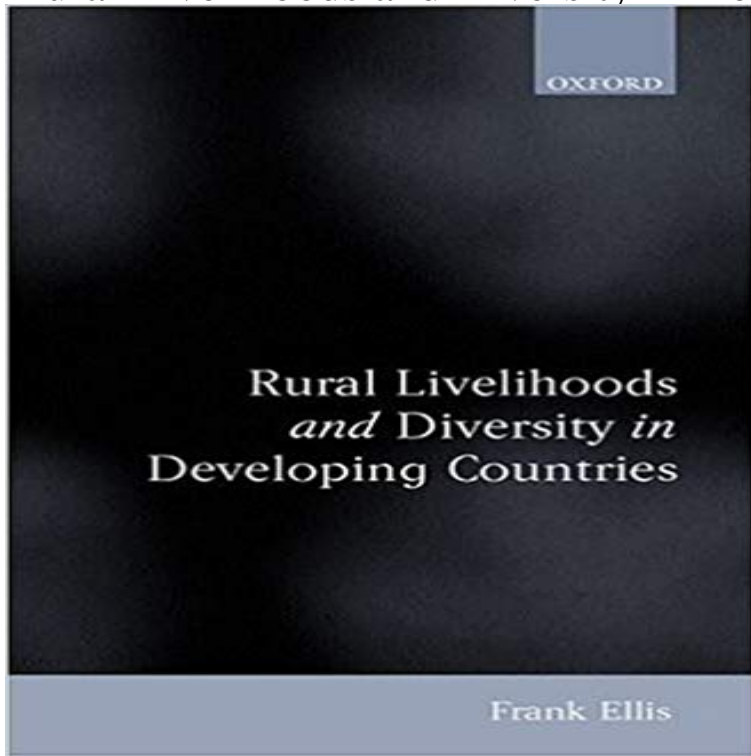


# Rural Livelihoods and Diversity in Developing Countries
