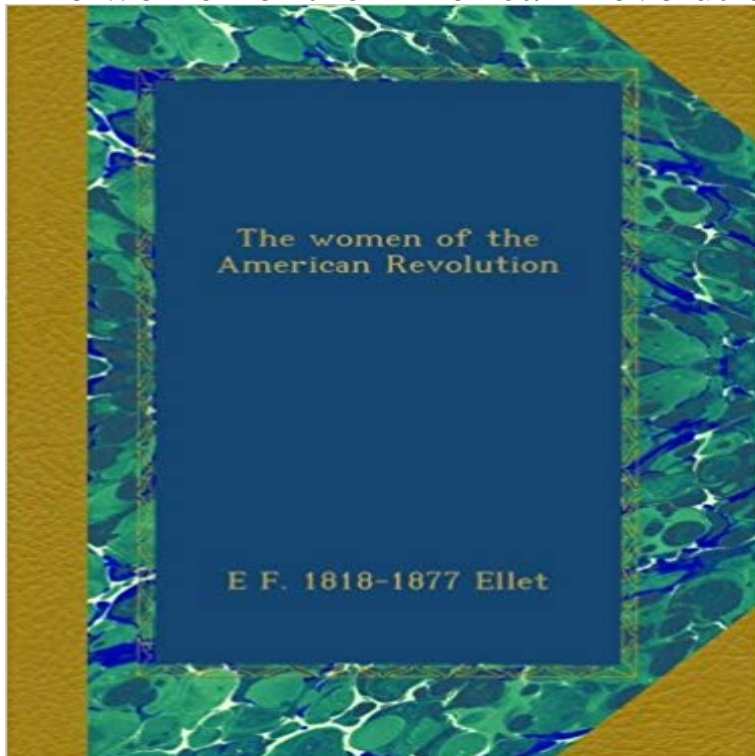


## The women of the American Revolution
